the author did not format the essay correctly, did not argue his/her point of view accurately enough, and did not use the evidence given in the essay correctly;

the author highlighted paragraphs, which gave visual control over the plan when writing the essay;

fully used arguments "for" and "against" when proving his/her point of view;

the author expressed his point of view on the statement accurately enough, gave good understandable examples.

How to write a social studies essay, do you need a clear essay plan, what criteria should the essay meet?

Despite the creative component of the essay, as an artistic genre, the writing plan should be. It does not need to be written into a ready-made essay, but it must be guided by it, otherwise the statement will be muddled, illogical. It is impossible to write a good essay at one time, you will have to rewrite it, which is as concise as possible to state your thoughts on the topic of the essay.

The topic of the essay should be chosen based on your knowledge, so that the arguments you will make in defense of your opinion are supported by authoritative sources, but your individual opinion is clearly highlighted. Of course, this is not highlighting in font or color, but only in the clarity of your presentation, the precision of your statement. Learn from the greats it is really so, because the aphorisms and sayings of writers, artists, scientists is why so firmly fixed in our memory, that they are logical and accurate.

The social studies essay must meet several criteria:

must reveal your understanding of the meaning of the proposed statement. This should be stated clearly, concisely and concisely;

the topic is disclosed with the support of theoretical concepts, provisions of science, relevant conclusions, opinions of people authoritative in this field;

always evaluated the level of statement of your opinion on the topic of the essay, justification of the point of view using both social and philosophical factors.

Social studies essays must use scientific terms, you cannot get by with everyday opinions or examples from social life here. The use of scientific argumentation will be a huge "plus" to your evidence.

You should not use the words of the author of the statement in the text of the essay in unchanged form, it is better to paraphrase them and it does not matter whether you agree with this statement or not.

Be sure to highlight the conclusions of the essay in a separate paragraph, in which you should formulate your thoughts as clearly as possible.
